FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK - - -

This weekend marks the end of our Christmas Season with the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord. May we never take for granted the gift of our Baptism. Becoming part of the family of the Church, we are called to actively help build the Kingdom of God. Carrying out the Spiritual and Corporal Works of Mercy on a regular basis is part of being a disciple of our Lord Jesus Christ.

We are resuming our men's prayer breakfast program "That Man Is You" this Thursday at the Parish Center at All Souls. We welcome newcomers to join us on Thursday mornings. Why not give it a try?

There will be some changes in our Annual Diocesan Appeal this year. There will be some discussions in our parish council meetings and with our Bishop. There will be an Appeal this year but at a time after Easter.

You may have noticed in the West Nebraska Register the appeal for funds to support operating the newspaper. So far only about 25% of the cost has been covered by donations already sent in. If you have not already donated, consider sending \$20.00 about the cost of each subscription. The Diocese automatically mails a newspaper for each Catholic household to keep our people informed. Make checks payable to West Nebraska Register, P.O. Box 608, Grand Island, NE 68803.

**JUBILEE YEAR OF MERCY HAS BEGUN** - Father has a very limited supply of the Magnificat booklet for a day-to-day observance of the Jubilee Year. These are available at cost in the amount of \$6.00 to be paid to Father Dave. Please keep your copy of the letter from our Bishop of the schedule for the yearlong observance of the Jubilee. There is a Jubilee Door at the Cathedral in Grand Island. If you pass through the Door and fulfill the requirements you may receive a partial or plenary indulgence. The requirements are: 1. Pass through the Holy Door. 2. Make a profession of faith (pray either the Nicene or Apostles Creed). 3. Make a short reflection on mercy. 4. Sacrament confession and reception of the Eucharist and a prayer for the Pope's intentions. Plan a pilgrimage to St. Mary's Cathedral.
