FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK - - -

We are beginning our first full week of Lent. Do make an effort to make it a meaningful season. What a great opportunity to do penance of some kind and to grow closer to our Lord.

Please make use of the Lenten materials available at church, including the Little Black Books. We will begin Stations of the Cross this week. There are other opportunities also available such as Symbolon, That Man Is You, and Sunday night Scripture study and the women's study group at Sacred Heart. Also, Lent is an excellent time to utilize the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Why not make a resolution to attend the weekday Mass scheduled at your church during this Lent. Pull yourself away from your television or computer. Sacrifice some treat and give the money to your Rice Bowl for Catholic Relief Services.

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are Days of FAST. We are allowed only one full but meatless meal. Two other small meatless meals are allowed but they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but you may have liquids. The obligation to fast begins after your 18th birthday and ends at the start of one's 60th.

In addition all Fridays during Lent are days of ABSTINENCE from meat. Meat and soup or gravy made from meat may not be taken. Everyone over the age of 14 is bound to observe the law.

When health or ability to work would be seriously affected, these regulations of fast and abstinence do not oblige, but do not excuse yourself lightly from this penitential obligation.

I wish to thank all the volunteers at the Sacred Heart Parish Super Bowl Dinner for all their efforts last Sunday. The food was delicious and the hospitality was warm. Over 235 meals were served this year. Again may God bless all those who gave of their time, talent and treasure in this effort to support our parish.
