FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK - - -

This week is our most important week of the entire church year. We recall the beginning of the Holy Eucharist on Holy Thursday, our Lord's suffering and death on Good Friday, and His glorious Resurrection on Easter Sunday. Try to participate in as many of these special observances as possible this week. Following the Mass of the Last Supper at All Souls in Bridgeport, there will be Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament until Midnight. Please stop at church to spend an hour with our Lord between 7:00 and Midnight.

Please note the difference of our Mass schedule above for the Easter Masses. Since the Vigil Mass is at All Souls, there will not be a 10:30 Mass in Bridgeport. The Easter Mass in Dalton will be at 10:30 AM. Please bring a hand bell along to the Easter Mass to be rung during the Gloria and during the recessional at the end of Easter Mass.

You may bring your Rice Bowl donations to church on Good Friday or during the Easter weekend. Try to help us out by converting your loose change into cash when you bring it in.

Place your blessed palms in your home in a prominent place for the year. May your home be blessed and protected. Return your old blessed palms to church or burn them in your garden.

We will again have the blessing of Easter foods at the end of the Easter Masses. Such foods such as colored Easter eggs, sausages, breads, rolls, butter, cakes, candy, etc. may be brought in a box or basket and placed on the designated table in front of church.

If you need to fulfill your Easter Duty, note in the schedule above the Communal Reconciliation services this Sunday and also the opportunity for individual confession this week.

Please remember that Good Friday binds us to abstinence from meat, and also it is a day of fasting for those between 18 and 60 years of age.

I wish to thank everyone who helped with the moving of the Food Pantry this past Thursday to our new location at 1011 Main Street in Bridgeport. This Pantry helps all Morrill County. Since there is work to getting everything set up, the Pantry will not reopen until Thursday, April 14th.
