It is good to be back after our Diocesan Priests' Retreat at the Terra Sancte Retreat Center near Rapid City. The silent retreat was conducted by Bishop Robert Gruss of Rapid City. It was intense but very good as he emphasized the spirituality of priesthood.

Our religious education classes are meeting on Wednesday evenings at all three churches. Please make sure your children are attending.

Again I remind our parishioners at All Souls to help with raising funds for our classroom space. We have about \$3,800.00 of the \$5,000 being raised. Please help our young people.

Did you know that 30% of those discharged from psychiatric hospitals end up homeless within six months of release? Research has shown that 20% of state prisoners and 21% of local prisoners have had a recent history of mental illness.
