FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK -

October is designated by the Church as Respect Life Month. We include all human life from the unborn to natural death that is deserving of protection. Most often we think of protection of the unborn from abortion. I invite you to join me on the Life Chain on Main Street in Bridgeport. You choose a sign to hold in silent witness for an hour to stress the importance of this issue to all who drive by. If you've never had the experience, try it. Bring a folding chair along if standing is difficult. One of the topics often overlooked is that of the death penalty. This may touch a raw nerve for some people; the Church believes the lives of notorious criminals are to be respected. God gives life, and he should be the one who takes life. Please take time to read the bulletin insert today on the death penalty.

Our Nebraska Bishops are asking Catholics in voting to retain the ban on the death penalty in our state.

I wish to remind you that we are still taking donations for our classroom project at All Souls. We are still short about \$1,000. Please mark your check at the bottom "classroom project".
