FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK - This weekend I am pleased to have Father Sager from Kimball St. Joseph's speaking on vocations to the priesthood and religious life. I will be taking his place at Masses at Kimball. We are very fortunate to have Father serving in our Diocese far from his home in India.

This has been a challenging campaign season on the presidential level. Both major candidates have less than stellar credentials. There have been questions about Donald Trump's name calling of individuals and groups, as well as questionable moral behavior. There has been many questions on Hilary Clinton's honesty on a number of issues I am concerned that in 2015 at the Women in the World Summit, Clinton declared that "deep-seated cultural codes, religious beliefs and structural biases must be changed." That sounded like a threat to religious freedom. And consider also who as President will be appointing the Supreme Court Justice vacancies. When confronted with difficult choices we are called upon to select the lesser of two evils. Which candidate better reflects the dignity of the human person and the values you hold?

Shall Legislative Bill #268 be repealed? This Bill eliminated the Death Penalty and changed the maximum penalty to Life Imprisonment without parole. Our Catholic Bishops encourage you to RETAIN Bill 268 to retain mercy, justice and dignity.
