LENTEN REGULATIONS - ABSTINENCE from meat on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays of Lent for everyone over 14 years of age, except for those with health issues. FASTING on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday for those ages 18 thru 60. Fasting means one full meal (without meat) plus two small meals. There is no snacking between meals. These are obligations under pain of sin.
